<b>Explanatory text (short description of the programme):</b>	The main purpose of university undergraduate studies is to educate qualified bachelor degree students of psychology. Bachelors of psychology should be able to apply psychological knowledge in scientific and ethical way in different circumstances; they should have wide erudition, high psychological culture and a need for permanent professional development. The program consists of 41,5% of lectures and 58,5% of independent work. Students have to write degree thesis under the direction of a faculty member.
<b>Duration (months):</b>	3,5 years (7 semesters) 34 months (under special individual study plan for Erasmus Mundus student)
<b>Earliest start date:</b>	1st of September 2012
<b>Latest end date:</b>	30 June 2015
<b>Language Requirements:</b>	Students should have a good command of both written and spoken English (B2 level under Common European Framework; 5.0-5.5 under IELTS band; 87-109 under TOEFL iBT). Candidates who can prove that their entire university education was taken in English can be exempted from this requirement.
<b>Academic Requirements:</b>	To be a psychology bachelor degree student in other university. Students should also have a good command of both written and spoken English.
<b>Mechanism of recognition and transfer used by the University:</b>	According to ECTS standards
<b>Fees:</b>	Tuition fee 1680 eur/year, Application fee 100 eur, Temporary residence permit fee 115 eur/year. All fees for Erasmus Mundus scholarship holder shall be paid directly from the project budget.
