<p>Admission requirements (for each Exchange Type of Mobility):</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Have a good command of English language, both written and spoken (preferably with B2 level under Common European Framework) and home institution must certify that a student has sufficient language skills (such certification must be signed and stamped by home institution) - Courses in other languages are complementary to English courses and no certification of language skills is required but students have to comply with the course requirements and so have to have a good command of German/French/Russian language (preferably B2) - Candidates who can prove that their entire university education was taken in English (for example in a Commonwealth country) can be exempted from this requirement - One year of law studies at home institution must be completed at the time of application process for exchange programme
<p>Academic calendar (for each Exchange Type of Mobility):</p>	<p>Each semester last 14 weeks – exact dates of semesters are set up each year for following academic year</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Autumn semester runs from mid September to mid December and exam period starts at the beginning of January and ends first week of February) - Summer semester runs from mid February to mid May; exam period starts in mid May and ends first week in July) <p>(Summer semester in the 3rd year of Bachelor studies is shorter – starts mid February and ends at the end of April and the exam period is in May, at the end of semester students defend bachelor thesis and take final exam from administrative law)</p> <p>(Summer semester in the 2nd year of Master studies varies from usual semester and there are no courses, students only defend their thesis and take final exams from March to May)</p> <p>-Duration of semesters however do not have influence on English courses provided for exchange students</p>
