### Brief information:

Established in 1834, Taras Shevchenko National University of Kyiv is a leading higher education institution in Ukraine. The University has always been the centre for generations of intellectuals who influenced educational, scientific, political and cultural development of society. Currently, the University boasts some of Ukraine's best teaching and research potential. **Today Taras Shevchenko National University of Kyiv comprises:**

- 7 Institutes, 14 Faculties, 172 Departments
- Centres, Library, Museums, Observatory, Botanical Garden, Kaniv Nature Reserve, Recreation & Summer Schools Sites, Student Campus, Sports Centre, Restaurants & Cafeterias, and much more

Generally, 74 courses are offered in 17 fields of study, and in 38 areas of knowledge. More than 24,650 students are doing Bachelor's, Specialist', and Master's courses. The Scientific Library of the University holds more than 3 million volumes. Though the education at Taras Shevchenko National University is in Ukrainian, but there are number of courses taught in foreign languages.
